At CalTech (on March 14th) I'm planning to talk about my "Device-independent quantum key distribution" paper (the one I talked about at the QuICS Stakeholder's Day). Ideally I'd like to have the paper posted on the arXiv before the talk. However I was slow in finishing up the paper (my fault) and I only got a complete draft ready on Feb. 28th.
