## Parking Information (for those staying off-campus)

**Please park in the MESA/18 parking structure ONLY.** You will need to buy a “pay and display” permit (**\$8 per day weekdays**) from the machine in the parking structure. If you look for Crypto & NIST-PQC on the permit machine, you can pay for the total number of days that you will be parking in the lot and be issued a permit for that period of time. Note that **after 5pm and on weekends**, you may use the same permit for **Lot 3 or 9** for evening events.

## **Lunch Purchases** (for those staying off-campus)

You may purchase lunch tickets for dining in **De La Guerra Commons** Friday and/or Saturday. Tickets are \$12.00 each and may be purchased in several ways:

- **Corwin Pavilion Lobby:** If you are attending **Crypto**, lunch tickets are being sold during the following hours (accepting cash and credit card):
  - Mon: 8am - 4pm
  - Tues: 8am - 12:30pm
  - Wed: 8am - 3:30pm
  - Thurs: 8am - Noon
- **Santa Rosa Hall.** See Brian Shively at the Conference & Hospitality Services office right next to the Santa Rosa front desk (accepting cash and credit). **Friday Only: 8am -12pm and 1pm – 5pm.**
- **De La Guerra Dining Commons:** purchase and pay directly for your lunch at the Lobby Desk (VISA and Mastercard accepted).
- If you don't plan to dine at De La Guerra Commons, there are **food court options** within University Center. These vendors will take payment directly. Please note that most of the eateries are **closed on Saturday** for summer break.

## **Travel**

- **By Air:** For your convenience, we recommend making flight reservations with Santa Barbara Municipal Airport (SBA) as your final destination. The UCSB campus is a ten-minute drive from the airport.
- **Santa Barbara Airbus (bus shuttle from LAX):** This service provides several daily bus trips from Los Angeles International Airport to Santa Barbara. Reservations are strongly recommended (see [www.sbairbus.com](http://www.sbairbus.com)).
- **By Train:** Santa Barbara is served by Amtrak Train Service. Amtrak terminals are located in Santa Barbara (12–15 miles from campus) and Goleta (5 miles from campus).
